The City of Columbia has been allocated \$524,731 for the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP), under Title XII of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing funds must be used to assist homeless and at-risk persons who would be homeless without this assistance.
