**Parking** As a consequence of a discussion concerning St. Patrick's Day spillover, Raj Aluri touched on the overflow from Five Points and the idea of extending our current neighborhood parking ordinance 24/7. As there appears to be an increase in crime and noise at Five Points, it might indeed be appropriate to enlarge the scope of our parking ordinance so that Five Points patrons do not park in the University Hill Neighborhood. This would have both a safety aspect as well as reduction of noise aspect to it.
