City of Columbia Performing Gervais Street Cleaning & Lining Project

The City of Columbia has engaged a private contractor, Carolina Tap and Bore, Inc. of West Columbia to rehabilitate the water lines along Gervais Street from the Congaree River to Trenholm Road.

The work is currently underway along Gervais Street between Trenholm Road and Heidt Street. In order to continue, it is necessary to install a water valve on Heidt Street. This work will require an interruption of service to some customers. The areas affected will be as follows:
