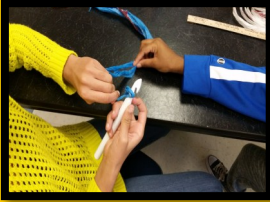


Columbia Art Center March 2019 Workshops



Plarn Crochet Workshop (Instruction by Bohumila Augustinova and Brenda Oliver)

Wednesday, March 20 from 6-8 pm
Columbia Art Center, 1227 Taylor St., Ste. C, Columbia SC 29201

This workshop will teach participants how to crochet with “plarn” and make portable sleeping mats for the homeless. There is no registration fee but participants must be registered to attend. Workshop is limited to a minimum of 3 and maximum of 15 participants. Suitable for teens through adults.



Pysanka (Ukrainian egg created with a written wax technique) (Instruction by Yevheniia (Jenna) Bazaliy)

Saturday March 23, 2019; 10 am—12 pm
Columbia Art Center, 1227 Taylor Street, Columbia SC 29201

Pysanka are objects of traditional folk art and are created by a method that is similar to batik. Patterns are drawn on the egg with hot beeswax, which then protects the covered areas from the dye that is applied afterwards. By repeating this process with different colors of dye, a multi-colored pattern is built up. Finally the wax is removed to reveal the colors that were sequentially covered up at each stage. Workshop is limited to a minimum of 2 and maximum of 12 participants. **Registration fee:** \$40 (includes all supplies.)
